Becoming A Trustee

Llanfallteg Memorial Playing Field is a registered Charity. It abides by its 'Governing Document', which is the constitution. To fully understand what becoming a Trustee means you should read the constitution and the Charity Commissions 'CC3 – The Essential Trustee' guide found online.

What is the objective of the Playing Field charity?

- The provision and maintenance of the playing field in Llanfallteg for the benefit of the local and wider community.
Our constitution says "...the provision and maintenance of a village hall and recreation ground for the use of the inhabitants of the Llanfallteg East and Llanfallteg West Wards..."

Who can become a Trustee - Are you eligible?

- You must be a minimum age of 18 years, a fit and proper person and not be disqualified from being a trustee of a charity. Other conditions may apply.

What is a Trustee?

- Trustees are the persons having the general control and management of the administration of a charity. Trustees have the overall legal responsibility for a charity.

Responsibilities to the charity

1. Ensure your charity is carrying out its purposes for the public benefit
2. Comply with your charity's governing document and the law
3. Act in your charity's best interests
4. Ensure your charity is accountable
5. Manage your charity's resources responsibly
6. Act with reasonable care and skill
